Following a discussion of the Board of Education of the School District, and based upon the written recommendation received from New York Municipal Advisors Corporation, the School District's Financial Advisor, it is hereby determined that the proposal of Banc of America Public Capital Corp, or one of its affiliates (the "Lessor"), which represents the lowest responsible bid received by the School District, is hereby accepted.

The President of the Board of Education, the Vice President of the Board of Education, the Superintendent of Schools and/or the Interim Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations (collectively the "Authorized Representatives" and individually, the "Authorized Representative") acting on behalf of the School District, are hereby authorized to negotiate, enter into, execute, and deliver one or more lease purchase agreements (the "Equipment Lease") with the Lessor. The Authorized Representatives are hereby further authorized to negotiate, enter into, execute, and deliver such other documents relating to the Equipment Lease (including, but not limited to, escrow agreements) as the Authorized Representatives deem necessary and appropriate. All other related contracts and agreements necessary and incidental to the Equipment Lease are hereby authorized, and such documents shall be filed in the office of the District Clerk and made available for public inspection.

Section 4. The aggregate original principal amount of the Equipment Lease shall not exceed the \$_____ and shall bear interest as set forth in the Equipment Lease and shall contain such options for prepayment as set forth therein.

Section 5. The School District's obligations under the Equipment Lease shall be subject to annual appropriation or renewal by the Board of Education of the School District as set forth in each Equipment Lease and the School District's obligations under the Equipment Lease shall not constitute a general obligation of the School District or indebtedness under the Constitution or laws of the State of New York.

Section 6. The proceeds of the Equipment Lease may be applied to reimburse the School District for expenditures made after the effective date of this resolution for the purpose for which said proceeds are authorized, or on or prior to such date if the Board of Education of
