Total Expenditures and Total Tax Levy for the School District and the Library

WHEREAS, the estimated **expenditure budget** for the **Amityville Union Free School District**, for the school year 2012-13 in the amount of \$78,211,501 was approved by the voters on May 15, 2012, and

WHEREAS, the estimated **expenditure budget** for the **Amityville Public Library**, for the fiscal year 2012-13 in the amount of **\$2,660,179** was approved by the voters of the District on April 3, 2012, and

WHEREAS, the combined total approved school district budget plus library budget is equal to \$80,871,680, and

WHEREAS, a portion of these approved expenditures must be funded through a property tax levy, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2012-13 School Tax Levy in the amount of \$52,739,785 for the Amityville Union Free School District and the 2012-13 Library Tax Levy in the amount of \$2,577,149 for the Amityville Public Library, for a combined tax levy of \$55,316,934, be approved and levied upon the real property of the District.

Said property taxes shall be apportioned between school district real property located in the Towns of Babylon and Oyster Bay according to the equalized full value of each segment, and shall reflect any and all adjustments related to the respective Equalization Rates as follows:

RESOLVED, that \$16,503,262.16 for School purposes and \$811,665.20 for Library purposes, be raised by taxation for that part of the Amityville Union Free School District located within the Town of Oyster Bay, Nassau County, New York, for the 2012-13 school year and be levied upon the \$2,424,681 Taxable Assessed Valuation of the said School District as said Assessed Value has been certified by the Board of Assessors.

The <u>approximate</u> Class tax rates per \$100 of assessed valuation that will result from the levying of said taxes in the Town of Oyster Bar are <u>estimated</u> in the table that follows.

The <u>actual</u> Class One thru Class Four tax rates per \$100 of assessed valuation that will result from the levying of said taxes in the Town of Oyster Bay <u>depend upon the Final Base Proportions</u>. The Final Base Proportions were not available as of the date this resolution was prepared. Last year, the Base Proportions became available the last week in September. For estimation purposes, the 2011-12 Base Proportions were used to estimate the tax rates for each Class. The actual Final Tax Levy and Final Taxable Assessed Values were used to compute the approximate 2012-13 Tax Rates.

Generally, the Oyster Bay tax rates are computed by the Nassau County Assessor and are provided to the school district well after the tax levy has been set.
