Amend Terms of Bradford McColgan Stein Memorial Scholarship

Whereas, the Board of Education adopted a Resolution on April 17, 1961, and agreed to administer a scholarship fund dedicated to the memory of Owen Bradford, Gary McColgan and Steven Stein, members of the 1961 senior class of the Amityville High School who died together on Great South Bay on April 13, 1961, and,

Whereas, an ad hoc committee of local citizens met on April 22, 1961 to undertake solicitation of funds for the purpose of funding the Bradford McColgan Stein Memorial Scholarship, and,

Whereas, the "Deed of Gift" prepared by L. Van Nostrand, Jr., Counselor at Law stipulates that a "grant in aid" shall be awarded annually to a graduate or graduates of the Amityville High School who meet the criteria defined in the Deed, and that said grant shall be "from the income thereof," and,

Whereas, the ". . . amount of \$9,221.99 plus any additional amount subsequently received be [was] and the same hereby is [was] given to have and to hold forever . . ," and,

Whereas, the balance in the account as of June 6, 2012 is \$25,810.75, and,

Whereas, the total interest earned from July 1, 2011 thru and including June 6, 2012 was \$49.60 and thus constitutes the "income thereof" as defined in the Deed, and that is available to fund the award for 2012, and,

Whereas, the sum of \$49.60 is insufficient to properly honor the memory of Owen Bradford, Gary McColgan and Steven Stein, nor is this amount consistent with the expectations of those who established and those who contributed to the memorial scholarship fund, and,
