

TIPS FOR INTERNET SAFETY

- ❖ Don't give out personal information: your name, phone number, address, name of our school, team or other information that can identify you.
- ❖ Don't open e-mail attachments unless you confirm it with your parent/guardian.
- ❖ Don't arrange a face-to-face meeting or phone conversation with another computer user without your parent/guardian's approval.
- ❖ Tell your parent/guardian when anyone uses bad language or says things that make you uncomfortable.
- ❖ Never send pictures or post at any website pictures without your parent/guardian approval.
- ❖ Don't click on any e-mail when you don't know the sender. Don't click on any advertisements or reward programs; it can lead to a virus on your computer.
- ❖ Learn how to block or ignore people who are being nasty or bullying.
- ❖ If there is a threat or bullying that is not stopping, tell a parent/guardian they may want to print it out.
- ❖ Don't share any passwords with anyone.
- ❖ Tell a parent/guardian if a stranger tries to contact you by e-mail or instant message.
- ❖ Tell a parent/guardian when at a friend's house they go on sites you are not allowed on or use the computer to bully others.
- ❖ If you write a message while angry, take a few seconds and read it over before you send it. You probably will change it after cooling down.
- ❖ Never pass on nasty gossip or use the computer to hurt others.
