Any person shall be entitled to have his or her name placed on the register of voters provided that he or she is known or proven to the satisfaction of the Board of Registration to be entitled to vote at said District meeting.

Essential Repairs Needed at Your Schools

No New Taxes Required - Funding is Available from Settlement

On June 4, 2009 the Board of Education of the Amityville Union Free School District received \$2,500,000 in the settlement of litigation related to capital construction and renovations to the Park Avenue Elementary School.

These funds have been deposited and are accounted for within the School District's Capital Fund, and, with public approval, can be appropriated for capital construction and/or renovations.

Because the funds are already in the Capital Fund, **approval of this proposition will not require any new taxes.**

The Proposition that will be voted upon by the public on March 16, 2010 seeks the public's approval to expend the sum of \$2,500,000 from the Capital Fund to complete the following capital reconstruction and renovation projects, related site work, incidental work and equipment:

- Replacement of the roof on the Northeast Elementary School.
- Replacement of the roof on the Northwest Elementary School.

- Districtwide renovation projects to enhance safety and improve overall building function by replacing internal communications equipment and systems, including, but not limited to building intercom systems, telephone and data systems.
- Districtwide site work, including but not limited to sidewalk repair, parking lot repair, etc.
